



**NOTICE OF OPEN BIDDING PROGRAMME FOR NEW GENERATION CAPACITY IN
YEAR 2029 TO 2031**

**REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (“RFP”) FOR THE SELECTION OF QUALIFIED
DEVELOPERS**

To ensure the stability of electricity supply and to maintain the electricity reserve margin in Peninsular Malaysia at an optimal level, the Energy Commission, on behalf of the Government, invites interested companies or consortium to submit proposals for the supply of electricity generation from new plants scheduled to commence operations between 2029 and 2031.

In this regard, an open and competitive bidding exercise for the New Generation Capacity in Year 2029 to 2031 (“NEWGEN26”) will be conducted for the development of new gas-fired power plants.

The Energy Commission invites interested companies or consortium with relevant experience in development of power generation projects including project financing and power plant operations to participate in the competitive bidding process in accordance with the criteria set forth in the RFP document.

The RFP document will be available for purchase online via the Energy Commission’s website at www.st.gov.my from **2 March 2026 at 9:00 a.m.** until **13 March 2026 at 5:00 p.m.**, with a non-refundable fee of **RM30,000.00** per RFP document.

Completed bid submissions must be submitted to and received by the Energy Commission no later than **1 July 2026 at 12:00 noon** at the **Suruhanjaya Tenaga, Putrajaya**. Any changes to the document submission method will be communicated through the Energy Commission’s official website.

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
