

## NOTIS PEMBERITAHUAN

1. Suruhanjaya Tenaga (ST) telah menerbitkan Garis Panduan “**Guidelines for the Approval of Electrical Equipment**” Edisi 2024 yang telah didaftarkan pada 21 Jun 2024 dengan no. pendaftaran GP/ST/No.37/2024.
2. Bagi apa-apa pindaan baharu khususnya yang melibatkan spesifikasi standard, kuat kuasa pindaan dalam Garis Panduan adalah satu tahun dari tarikh garis panduan didaftarkan.
3. Garis Panduan ini telah dikemaskini dengan mengambilkira:
  - i) standard keselamatan dan *Minimum Energy Performance Standard* (MEPS) terkini bagi kelengkapan elektrik pengguna;
  - ii) keperluan dokumen sokongan Perakuan Pendaftaran Pengilang atau Pengimport (CoR);
  - iii) terma dan syarat-syarat permohonan Perakuan Kelulusan (CoA); dan
  - iv) penambahan sub-kategori baru kelengkapan elektrik pengguna.
4. Kegagalan mematuhi Garis Panduan ini boleh disabitkan dengan denda tidak melebihi RM 200,000.00 atau dipenjarakan selama tempoh tidak melebihi dua (2) tahun atau kedua-duanya.

6. Sehubungan dengan itu, pengilang dan pengimport adalah dinasihatkan mengambil tindakan sewajarnya selaras dengan ketetapan Garis Panduan.

## ANNOUNCEMENT NOTICE

1. The Energy Commission (ST) has published the "**Guidelines for the Approval of Electrical Equipment**" 2024 Edition which was registered on 21 June 2024 with registration no. GP/ST/No.37/2024.
2. For amendments especially those involving standard specifications, the date of coming into operation of these Guidelines will be one year from the registration date of these Guidelines.
3. These Guidelines have been reviewed taking into account:
  - i) safety standards and the latest Minimum Energy Performance Standard (MEPS) of consumer electrical equipment;
  - ii) requirements of supporting documents for the registration of manufacturer's or importer's Certificate of Registration (CoR);
  - iii) procedures of the application of Certificate of Approval (CoA); and
  - iv) additional of a new sub-category of consumer electrical equipment.
4. Failure to comply with these Guidelines on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding RM 200,000.00 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two (2) years or to both.
